(Laughs). 9 10 Breen: That's right. 11 12 Osmond: And so they, they can employ people. 13 14 Breen: Yes. 15 Hmm, so why don't we just talk first about ah, Erin said that ah, you had some, some new 16 Osmond: 17 information that... 18 19 Dunphy: Hmm, hmm. 20 21 Osmond: ...was, you felt would be important to us. 22 23 Dunphy: Yes. Hmm, you know every thing's happening, well everything happened so fast... 24 Osmond: 25 Hmm. 26 27 Dunphy: ...and the guys were there to talk to me like a few hours after I had found out about dad and that so you know as time's going by I'm just I guess more stuff is coming to me and stuff. But when 28 29 they asked me about if there was any weapons in the house and I said no... 30 31 Osmond: Hmm, hmm. 32 33 Dunphy: ...well there was a gun in the house belong to my grandfather. When my grandfather died dad 34 pretty much literally moved everything that was in his house, in my pop's house, over to our 35 house cause everything is technically antique, or was antiques in my dad's eyes. So you know 36 like one of the officers even mentioned they seen this big oar around and like there's lots of old 37 junk around is what I call it like it's, it's ready for the dump. 38 **Osmond:** 39 Hmm. 40 41 Dunphy: But it's just really old and it was my pops and dad wanted to keep it. So there was a gun. I'm 42 not familiar with guns. I can't tell you what it is. I can't tell you what it was. All I knows it

1 was about this long and it was old and brown and rusty and junk like falling apart and I'm pretty 2 sure there was a piece missing off of it. 3 4 Osmond: Okay. 5 6 Dunphy: So anyways and that was there in the house and when my dad got sick in January, I'm saying 7 January my father was in the hospital sometime between January and say the first of February 8 I'm not exactly sure of the dates... 9 10 Osmond: That's this year? 11 12 Dunphy: Yeah.. 13 14 Osmond: Okay. 15 16 Dunphy: And he was in there for a week. He went down by ambulance first time he got sent home and 17 then when he went back they kept him in. And hmm, when he was in the hospital I would go 18 down in the day time and feed the cats like I'm doing now same thing and I went down a few 19 days and cleaned up the house like I took out all the garbage and cleaned the kitchen and stuff 20 like that and the gun was behind the couch. When I moved the couch the gun was flat like say I 21 didn't lift the couch there was no need to lift down the dads he wasn't particular about like you 22 know what I mean. 23 24 Osmond: Hmm. 25 26 Dunphy: Like I do home so I wouldn't scratch the floor so I just probably even kicked out the couch and 27 it was kinda stuck under the couch. So you know I looked at it and it, it, it wasn't even a big 28 thing to me because I knew it was there in the house before so I just figured you know whatever 29 it was just hugged behind the couch it wasn't taken out a long time there was dust and dirt and 30 shit everywhere. So I just lifted it up and shoved it back down on the couch and just shoved the 31 couch back in. And I did mention to dad about it but it was never it was just like yeah it was 32 pops gun like the old thing that was there like if you, were you to the house? 33 34 Osmond: Yes I was. 35 36 Dunphy: Okay. So you know what's around the house. 37 Osmond: 38 Yeah. 39 40 Dunphy: Like there's stuff poked literally everywhere. 41 42 Osmond: Yeah.

5 1 Dunphy: So this was probably you know he probably moved some stuff over the past years and that, he, 2 that just got slung in there like chances are only for I mentioned it he probably would of had to 3 turn the house upside down to look for that if he wanted it. 4 5 Osmond: Sure. 6 7 Dunphy: And two of my uncles, my dad's brothers, have, knew exactly what gun it was because 8 apparently my other uncle Dick had, my pop had four guns. My uncle Dick has three. 9 10 Osmond: Hmm, hmm. 11 12 **Dunphy:** And this is the one how they knew what it was because obviously dad had this one. They 13 claimed that it was broken and all warped up and I think you might of even we told you this 14 before I think it was all warped up and you can tie it up was it Kev said? 15 16 Corcoran: Yeah I think Kev said it was tied up yeah. 17 18 **Dunphy:** Yeah Kev said it was like tied up. He said it was in the stable for years like it hadn't been used 19 and stuff like that. 20 21 Osmond: Yeah. 22 23 **Dunphy:** So I did see that and it was behind the couch. And you know I've been down the dads many 24 times since then at least once a week at the very least and you know he didn't clean up 25 obviously after I cleaned up so everything was still there and the boxes were still shoved in the 26 same way. So my issue thinking now is just you know the way I see it I know my dad I know 27 where he sat I know if the officer went in where he sat so I'm just wondering how my father 28 managed to go behind the couch and get the gun if per say that's how it went. 29 30 Osmond: Okay. 31 32 Dunphy: But like I said I have a lot of questions this is some of them. But I just find it a little hard to 33 understand like the cop was invited in my father must have been home literally two minutes I'd 34 say... 35 36 Osmond: Hmm. 37 38 **Dunphy:** ...like he pulled up in the driveway and then the officer who was parked down the road just must 39 of came right behind him. So he invited him in openly and then within 15 minutes like I can't 40 understand how my dad managed to get up and go behind the officer where he was sitting and 41 haul out this gun and then point at you. It doesn't make sense to me I'll be honest. 42 43 Osmond: Okay.

6 1 2 Dunphy: So... 3 4 Breen: And just one other thing... 5 6 **Dunphy:** Yeah. 7 8 Breen: ...that you told me about... 9 10 **Dunphy:** Okay. 11 12 Breen: ...something else in, in the living room. Hmm... 13 14 **Dunphy:** Oh the stick. 15 16 Breen: You told... 17 18 Dunphy: Okay yeah I think I definitely told you about the stick or I told... 19 20 Breen: Okay. 21 ...Galway. But since I moved out like I'm out, I'm 27 I've been out of the house since I was probably 25 26 19. 27 28 Osmond: Hmm, hmm. 29 30 Dunphy: So you know he just didn't care. So he just made a room for whatever his weed and stuff. And everyone around the area knows that he smokes weed. He has the medical marijuana thing and 31 32 he grows it. So he had this stick it's about this long and there's duct tape on the end of it. 33 There's still like barky shit on it and that too. 34 Osmond: 35 Hmm. 36 37 Dunphy: Sorry for my language. 38 Osmond: That's okay. 39 And hmm, I asked him this one time like what the fuck are you at with a stick in the house like 40 Dunphy: what's that for? And he kinda smirked at me and said that's in case anyone gets any ideas and 41 42 comes over me weed... 43

7 1 Osmond: Yeah. 2 3 Dunphy: ...or tries to get in and get me weed. 4 5 Osmond: Yeah. 6 7 Dunphy: So I know the stick was there. So you know in my head that was by his chair. My dad didn't clean up before this you know he got up enough 13 time to get in the shower brush his teeth and go not to mention he lived at our house for a week 14 right before all this happened. So you know it's not like he planned everything out. So you 15 know could it have been this stick that he was getting at, reaching for and then you know if this cop had seen that gun, and I'm not saying he's bad or anything like that... 16 17 18 Osmond: No, no. 19 20 ...but you know my dad could of pulled a stick on him and then if he sees the gun well how did-Dunphy: 21 you know he didn't put the gun there. 22 23 Osmond: Right. 24 25 Dunphy: But there was a stick there that he used for self, say he would use for self defense if someone 26 came. 27 28 Osmond: Hmm, hmm. 29 30 Dunphy: So you know the gun was never there for self defense. It was there because it was my pop's 31 and dad was too, had too big of a heart to throw it away he didn't you know, every, he kept 32 dressers and you now there's I bet you there's 12 dressers in our house. We had three 33 bedrooms. He kept everything. Every bed, every everything you know what I'm saying so I 34 just have a hard time believing this story about the gun I'll be honest. 35 36 Osmond: Okay. 37 38 **Dunphy:** So that's all that's coming back to me now. 39 40 Osmond: Yeah. 41 42 Dunphy: But there might you now there could end up being something else that triggers something else 43 but...
