8	Henstridge:	And when you were down there was he wearing any eye wear at the time?
9 10	Dinn:	Well he don't wear it all the time. He use to use it when he was texting or reading like a letter or something or if he was writing something.
11	Henstridge:	So he didn't always wear his glasses?
12 13	Dinn:	No. No. And I don't know if he wore 'em driving or not. $I - I - I$ don't. I really don't. And there were
14 15	Henstridge:	I'll let you – do you remember specifically if the day when you went down there he had his glasses that day?
16	Dinn:	Oh yeah.
17	Henstridge:	He had 'em on that day?
18	Dinn:	Yeah, twice.
19	Henstridge:	When you were down there on a Monday or Tuesday?
20	Dinn:	Yeah, off and on. Actually, they were an old – old set of glasses, right.
21 22	Henstridge:	Well let's – let's get to that. Can you describe the glasses to me the last time you saw 'em, as best you can?

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1	Dinn:	They're a pair of old man, silver glasses, I guess. Something like me
2		father wears type thing.

3 Henstridge: Yeah.

4 Dinn: Like an older style. And he had one of the ear bands taped on. They
5 were just an old pair of glasses that he use to use. He talked about gettin'
6 new ones a few times but never ever did, not to my knowledge if he ever
7 did.

8 Henstridge: Okay.

9 Dinn: Take her for a walk. That's what she wants. ..(laughing) ... She'll keep
10 barking. Oh poor old Maya

- Henstridge: So you said that, ah, they were an old pair of what you call old man or
 older style silver ...
- 13 **Dinn:** Yeah.
- 14 Henstridge: ... glasses.
- 15 **Dinn:** I think it was silverish.
- 16 **Henstridge:** And you said one of the ear bands was taped on.

17 **Dinn:** Yeah.

18 **Henstridge:** What color tape was on it?

19Dinn:Oh my god. I remember – well there was black tape on 'em at one time20and there was scotch tape on 'em another time. To say what was on 'em21on Monday or Tuesday I've – I – I'm – I'm not that – like I don't know. He22was me buddy so I never really sized him up every time I went in type23thing.

24 Henstridge: Okay.

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- 1 **Dinn:** You know.
- 2 Henstridge: You ever recall seeing white like ...
- 3 Dinn: Yeah. Medical tape?

4 Henstridge: Yeah.

5 **Dinn:** Yeah. I don't know but I gave him the roll of it the time he had his hand 6 tore up with the cat.

7 Henstridge: Okay.

- 8 Dinn: I didn't think anybody else was at his hands but the doctor was at the
 9 same that time when he tore his hands with the cat.
- 10 Henstridge: Okay yes, you mentioned ...
- 11 **Dinn:** He was ...
- 12 **Henstridge:** ... something about that.
- 13 **Dinn:** ... yeah, he was treated by well the same doctor, right ...
- 14 Henstridge: Yeah.
- 15 **Dinn:** ... that I goes to he was he use to go to.

16 Henstridge: Uhm...uhm.

Dinn: And actually I was the one I told him to go to the doctor because he wasn't
 gettin' help with other doctors. And I said well whatever McGarry will do,
 he'll help you out.

20 Henstridge: Uhm...uhm.

21Dinn:So he went to him anyway. And yesterday when I was down to the doctor22gettin' my report about me heart ...

- 2 **Dinn:** ... I kind of well we we we chatted a little about ...
- 3 Henstridge: Yeah.
- 4 **Dinn:** ... Donny because he's my friend and the doctor and whatever.
- 5 **Henstridge:** Uhm...uhm.
- 6 Dinn: And he said to me about the cats. He said cause he he said he
 7 treated him after.
- 8 Henstridge: Okay.
- 9 **Dinn:** Yeah.
- 10 Henstridge: Yeah, you mentioned the cats. Now he ...
- 11 **Dinn:** With my ...
- 12 **Henstridge:** ... he ... (unintel) ... through ...
- 13 **Dinn:** ... no man, he wouldn't hurt a fly.

 'em off and put 'em down and put 'em on again.

- Henstridge: When he put 'em down, can you remember where he put 'em or how heplaced 'em or?
- 21 **Dinn:** They were always laid I don't have a pair.
- Henstridge: I got a pair glasses. I'll let you show with mine.

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- 1 **Dinn:** Well usually he done that.
- 2 Henstridge: Closed 'em up.
- 3 Dinn: And he laid 'em right there on a ice cream tub on the table in front like
 4 he use to have like a little round table in front …
- 5 Henstridge: Yes.
- 6 **Dinn:** ... of his chair where he sat all the time.
- 7 Henstridge: So the way they're described to me there now is closed and ...
- 8 **Dinn:** Yeah.
- 9 Henstridge: ... sitting on the earpieces basically.
- 10 **Dinn:** Either be like that or sometimes ...
- 11 Henstridge: Or ...
- 12 **Dinn:** ... he just ...
- 13 Henstridge: Okay.
- 14 **Dinn:** ... lay 'em like that. Like I mean it just it was never ...

15 Henstridge: Yeah.

- 16Dinn:You know. He just took 'em off and lay 'em down though. Just he used17to be he had to be careful with 'em because of the earpiece, right.
- 18 Henstridge: Right.
- 19Dinn:They were fragile right there, so, instead of trying instead of losing it and20whatever he'd ...
- 21 Henstridge: What do you mean, losing it?
- 22 **Dinn:** The earpiece.

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1	Henstridge:	The earpiece on which side?
2 3	Dinn:	Yeah. Ah, jeez now. I think it was this side actually that the earpiece was missing on.
4	Henstridge:	So you're indicating the left side.
5 6 7	Dinn:	I believe so. I'm trying to – it's hard to picture stuff now. There's so much stuff goin' on in me own mind. Ah, jeez. Now tryin' – tryin' to picture him taking 'em off or puttin' 'em on. Yeah I believe it was that side boy.
8	Henstridge:	But you're not sure. That's fine.
9	Dinn:	Not a hundred percent.
10 11	Henstridge:	That's good. And, ah, so you said – first of all you said that there was tape on 'em
12	Dinn:	Here give you back your glasses.
13	Henstridge:	Yeah. I know.
14	Dinn:	(laughing)
15	Henstridge:	I'll be writing up the side of that. Ah,
16	Dinn:	Fair enough.
17 . 18	Henstridge:	So you said there was tape on 'em at certain times. There was black tape sometimes.
19	Dinn:	Yeah.
20	Henstridge:	Scotch tape sometimes.
21	Dinn:	I – I do remember seeing that white tape, yeah.
22	Henstridge:	As recently as the last time you saw him.

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1	Dinn:	Jeez, it could be. Like
2	Henstridge:	Just not sure but you did see it at some point.
3	Dinn:	Yes. They've been taped up over the years all with, you know
4 5	Henstridge:	Uhm. And then you said the ear – he had to be careful puttin' 'em down because – because of the ear piece.
6	Dinn:	Yeah.
7	Henstridge:	Either the left or right side. You're not
8	Dinn:	Yeah.
9	Henstridge:	sure not which.
10 11	Dinn:	Well say again when I had the – well cause your ear band is folded in but like it'd be just the one folded.
12	Henstridge:	And it was loose you mean or?
13 14 15	Dinn:	Yeah. Just – that one ear band that had cracked. What happened to it? No: What did he say happened to 'em, boy. It's hard remembering stuff when – when you don't think you have to.
16	Henstridge:	Uhmuhm.
17	Dinn:	Like – no, they're – they were broke a long while, that ear band thing.
18 19	Henstridge:	Okay. How about the centre piece? Was there anything wrong with the nose piece that you remember?
20	Dinn:	No, I don't think. I mean he use to wear 'em so.
21	Henstridge:	Yeah. Did you ever know the lenses to come out? Did he ever
22	Dinn:	No.

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1	Henstridge:	have trouble with that?
2 3	Dinn:	Never had any – not that I know of. Not any time I was there. I'll say it that way cause I don't know.
4	Henstridge:	Yeah, you can only speak to what you saw, eh boy.
5	Dinn:	Yes.
6 7	Henstridge:	Okay, I'm just gonna go through this now and if – sometimes when I repeat it
8	Dinn:	Yeah.
9 10	Henstridge:	back to you it might stimulate some other memory or something about the glasses, right.
11	Dinn:	Yeah, fair enough.
12	Henstridge:	You said that the last time you saw Don was probably Tuesday \dots
13	Dinn:	Yeah.
14	Henstridge:	or Monday of the previous
15	Dinn:	Yeah.
16	Henstridge:	of that week.
17	Dinn:	Yeah.
18 19	Henstridge:	And you were down there and – and you recall that he was using his glasses then that he was texting somebody or
20	Dinn:	Tweeting I think.
21	Henstridge:	Tweeting or writing. And he took them off and put 'em on
22	Dinn:	Yeah.

- 1 Henstridge: ... twice as far ...
- 2 **Dinn:** Well
- 3 Henstridge: ...as you remember.
- 4 **Dinn:** Yeah, at least twice, right.
- 5 **Henstridge:** You described the glasses as an old pair of what you call old man or old 6 style silver glasses.
- 7 Dinn: Yeah, well they're that shaped lens like the same as me father wears.
 8 They're kind of rec they're not square but they're not rectangle either.
 9 They're kind of in between.
- 10 Henstridge: Yeah. And you said one of the ear bands, you believe it ...
- 11 **Dinn:** I believe ...
- 12 Henstridge: ... was the left ...
- 13 **Dinn:** Yeah.
- 14 Henstridge: ... but you're not sure. Could have been the right. Ah ...
- 15Dinn:Trying jeez, I can't remember. I can't believe I can't remember that.16Tut, tut. He use to go I don't know.
- 17 **Henstridge:** Memory isn't perfect boy.
- 18 **Dinn:** No.
- 19 Henstridge: You know, it's not something you necessarily you're gonna pay close ...
- 20 **Dinn:** Mine ...
- 21 Henstridge: ... attention to.

- Dinn: ... is not a hundred percent now either because of all the medication I
 takes.
- 3 Henstridge: Yeah. Yeah.
- 4 **Dinn:** Just trying to have to go back days now try to remember.
- 5 Henstridge: Like I said, if you do remember ...
- 6 **Dinn:** Yeah.
- 7 Henstridge: ... at a later time just give ...
- 8 **Dinn:** I'll let you know.
- 9 Henstridge: ... just give me a shout.
- 10 **Dinn:** Yeah, no worries.
- Henstridge: So it was either the left or the right and it was taped on. And at various
 times since you've known him it's been taped on with black tape. I ...
- 13 Dinn: Yeah.
- 14 **Henstridge:** ... I assume you mean like electrical tape.
- 15 **Dinn:** Electrical tape, yeah.
- 16 Henstridge: Scotch tape at other times...
- 17 **Dinn:** Uhm...uhm.
- 18 Henstridge: ... and you do recall seeing white tape on there.
- 19 **Dinn:** Yes sir.
- Henstridge: Was there ever any tape that you recall on any other place besides that
 band? Was there ever any ...
- 22 **Dinn:** No.

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- 1 **Henstridge:** Only on that band.
- 2 **Dinn:** Just on the ear piece, yeah, or the eye ear piece, yeah.
- 3 Henstridge: And you had conversations with him ...
- 4 **Dinn:** Uhm...uhm.
- 5 **Henstridge:** ... over the years about getting new new glasses.
- 6 **Dinn:** Now he had said about it because they were broke, right.
- 7 Henstridge: Right.
- 8 Dinn: And the same as there's like anybody in his situation he said he couldn't
 9 afford to get new glasses ...
- 10 Henstridge: Sure.
- 11 **Dinn:**so.
- 12 Henstridge: Yeah.
- 13 **Dinn:** He use to keep them and patch 'em up.
- 14 Henstridge: Yeah.

15 **Dinn:** And he's – he always had 'em on him.

- Henstridge: You indicated that when you saw him lodge him down it was oftentimes on
 that blue Tupperware ..
- 18 **Dinn:** Yeah.
- 19 Henstridge: ... container.
- 20 **Dinn:** Yeah or ice cream tub.
- 21 Henstridge: Or ice cream tub. Okay.

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1 **Dinn:** He – he use to have an ice cream tub on the ...

2 Henstridge: And that he'd have 'em either up - on ...

3 **Dinn:** Yeah.

Henstridge: ... the recording I'm basically describing them being kind of folded and
 upside down ...

6 **Dinn:** Yeah.

7 Henstridge: ... or ...

8 **Dinn:** Or laid out just with ear bands out and ...

9 Henstridge: ... or the ear bands out ...

10 **Dinn:** ... and – and laid down.

11 Henstridge: And folded upside down.

12 **Dinn:** Yeah. It just depended on ...

13 Henstridge: Yeah.

14**Dinn:**... if he took 'em off like quick and laid 'em down or if he took 'em off15and...

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16 Henstridge: Sure.

17 **Dinn:** ... folded 'em, laying 'em down.

Henstridge: Sure. Okay. Is there anything else that stands out to you about theglasses?

20Dinn:No, not really boy. He – just that he use to have to wear 'em to read or21text or anything like that.

19	Henstridge:	Yeah. Ah, you been talking to Meghan and stuff.
