Myself and S/Sgt. TILLER checked exhibit # PE9 (SMYTH's jacket), and it does not appear to have any visible blood-like staining on it.

15:35

S/Sgt. TILLER opens a temp locker, where Cpl. LEE had returned the .22 cal rifle found at DUNPHY's residence. An intact exhibit sticker was over the seal, and there was a note from Cpl. LEE, which stated she had returned the rifle on April 10th @ 16:45.

I, then, placed the rifle back inside the main exhibit room, and S/Sgt. TILLER locked the door.
