Facts of the statement are as follows:

Cpl. O'KEEFE was first supervisor on scene.

Cpl. O'KEEFE had first conversation with SMYTH.

SMYTH told Cpl. O'KEEFE that there was a firearm pointed at him and he did shoot Mr. DUNPHY.

No other utterances were made.

Cpl. O'KEEFE seized firearm from SMYTH.

Cpl. O'KEEFE locked pistol in car, unsure in there was a clip in pistol or not. Did not eject a round from the pistol when seized.

Cpl. O'KEEFE felt that Mr. SMYTH's demeanor was disbelief.

Cpl. O'KEEFE stated that Mr. SMYTH was placed in PC until transported back to Holyrood detachment.

Statement ended.
