- 1 **CST. NIPPARD:** Alright, the time is 7:23 PM, it's April the 5<sup>th</sup>, 2015 and could you  
2 state your full name?
- 3 **R.NOLAN:** Rochelle Maureen NOLAN
- 4 **CST. NIPPARD:** How do you spell Rochelle?
- 5 **R.NOLAN:** R-O-C-H-E-L-L-E
- 6 **CST. NIPPARD:** Okay, NOLAN?
- 7 **R.NOLAN:** Yeah
- 8 **CST. NIPPARD:** And what's your date of birth Rochelle
- 9 **R.NOLAN:** [REDACTED]
- 10 **CST. NIPPARD:** What's your address here
- 11 **R.NOLAN:** Box [REDACTED] Mount Carmel
- 12 **CST. NIPPARD:** You have a street address as well, or...
- 13 **R.NOLAN:** We just got a civic address actually
- 14 **CST. NIPPARD:** Oh, okay
- 15 **R.NOLAN:** Ah, [REDACTED]
- 16 **CST. NIPPARD:** And that's Mitchell's Brook, right

17 **R.NOLAN:** Yes, do you mind if I have a cigarette

18 **CST. NIPPARD:** Go right ahead

19 **R.NOLAN:** I'm having a hot flash

20 **CST. NIPPARD:** Alright, my name is Cst. NIPPARD, like I told ya, I'm with the Major  
21 Crimes in St. John's, Newfoundland with the RCMP, ah, I know  
22 we've been talking a fair bit about, ah, Donald DUNPHY next door,  
23 so if you could just, just start from wherever you think is right I  
24 guess in your own head from the beginning is what I'd like to say,  
25 but, ah, start from wherever you think is right, just tell me everything  
26 you know about Donnie and I know some of it may be hearsay,  
27 what you just heard through other people but, ah, just what ya, what  
28 ya know about him and his lifestyle and, and who he is and what not

29 **R.NOLAN:** Donnie has been a widow I'm gonna say for the last twenty six  
30 years, his wife died in a, due to diabetes, has an only child Megan,  
31 ah, got hurt years ago working for, ah, Department of Highways,  
32 was not working for years and years, has been on disability or  
33 Workers Comp or whatever for years, ahm, very kept, very much to  
34 hisself, never had no issues with him until my son went after one of  
35 his kittens years ago, ah, then we had a few words but other than  
36 that everything was fine and say hi and hello if I'd meet him at the  
37 store or whatever or passing by the road, other than that, he was no  
38 problem

39 **CST. NIPPARD:** So the, Megan is his only child, right

40 **R.NOLAN:** Yes

41 **CST. NIPPARD:** What's her, do you know her last name

42 **R.NOLAN:** DUNPHY

43 **CST. NIPPARD:** How old is Megan

44 **R.NOLAN:** I'm thinking twenty eight

45 **CST. NIPPARD:** Where did you say she lives

46 **R.NOLAN:** On the Salmonier Line

47 **CST. NIPPARD:** She doesn't have any kids of her own you said

48 **R.NOLAN:** No

49 **CST. NIPPARD:** And you said she's living common-law, she's not married right

50 **R.NOLAN:** No

51 **CST. NIPPARD:** Who's her spouse

52 **R.NOLAN:** I know his first name is Billy

53 **CST. NIPPARD:** Okay, how long has Donald lived next door

54 **R.NOLAN:** A lifetime, his Mom and Dad lived two doors up from where he's  
55 living now

56 **CST. NIPPARD:** Now you said you've been here for, in this house for twelve years,  
57 right

58 **R.NOLAN:** Yes

59 **CST. NIPPARD:** And did he live over there this whole time that you've lived here

60 **R.NOLAN:** Yes

61 **CST. NIPPARD:** Okay

62 **R.NOLAN:** He's lived there since before he had Megan actually

63 **CST. NIPPARD:** Oh, okay

64 **R.NOLAN:** As far as I know

65 **CST. NIPPARD:** Now you spoke to me earlier about some, you said, ah, he was  
66 growing marijuana over there, tell me what you know about that or  
67 what, well what you've heard about that obviously

68 **R.NOLAN:** A few years back, like, several, several years, I'm gonna say, fifteen  
69 years ago or more

70 **CST. NIPPARD:** Okay

71 **R.NOLAN:** He got caught for growing illegal marijuana

72 **CST. NIPPARD:** Okay

73 **R.NOLAN:** So I've heard

74 **CST. NIPPARD:** Okay and you were saying that he's still doing that over there now  
75 or...

76 **R.NOLAN:** Apparently he's, again, I can only tell you what I'm after hearing

77 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

78 **R.NOLAN:** Ah, he's allowed to grow it for medical reasons, for himself

79 **CST. NIPPARD:** Now I know we spoke about the, the issue with the, ah, the cat, tell  
80 me about that again

81 **R.NOLAN:** Ah, my son was probably nine

82 **CST. NIPPARD:** It was your other son right

83 **R.NOLAN:** My oldest son

84 **CST. NIPPARD:** Your oldest son

85 **R.NOLAN:** He's sixteen now

86 **CST. NIPPARD:** Okay

87 **R.NOLAN:** He was probably nine or ten where you were seven or eight

88 **CST. NIPPARD:** Okay

89 **R.NOLAN:** [REDACTED] my youngest son, came home because Donnie was after  
90 going at him like a spider monkey, ah, he came home crying to me

91 and said Mom, Donnie DUNPHY went off his head at me because I  
92 was down over the bank trying to save one of the kittens cause I  
93 thought they were going to go into the pond

94 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

95 **R.NOLAN:** So I said, [REDACTED] you stay here, Mom's gonna go over and talk to  
96 Donnie, he wouldn't allow me to over by myself cause he's a very  
97 protective child, his Dad was away working at the time as per  
98 normal, he came with me and before I got to Donnie's house,  
99 Donnie came down on the road and met me so I never even had to  
100 go up in his driveway and face me, like, face to face and started  
101 going off his head and [REDACTED] came home screeching and bawling  
102 because I told him to go home cause Donnie was furious and, ah,  
103 after that there was no hard feelings, no nothing, but at the time  
104 there was major issues, I had a major issue, like, you don't come  
105 after a nine or a ten year old

106 **CST. NIPPARD:** No

107 **R.NOLAN:** With, over a cat when you have fifty over there

108 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

109 **R.NOLAN:** He was trying to save one of 'em from going into the pond, it's only  
110 a kitten

111 **CST. NIPPARD:** M'hmm

112 **R.NOLAN:** Ah, you don't go after a small child like a spider monkey, so...

113 **CST. NIPPARD:** How many cats does he have over there

114 **R.NOLAN:** Oh my god

115 **CST. NIPPARD:** Do you think

116 **R.NOLAN:** I counted, I'm gonna tell ya, twenty five one day, just marching up  
117 the meadow but there was double that and then some, you could

118 not stand, walking a past that house during the summer, you  
119 couldn't stand the smell of cat urine and waste, when the heat hit it,  
120 it was unbelievable

121 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

122 **R.NOLAN:** I called the SPCA and they told me they couldn't do nothing about it  
123 until, unless I actually, literally caught him in a kennel and brought  
124 'em out

125 **CST. NIPPARD:** Now you said you've, you've seen people going back and forth his  
126 house and I guess you don't really know what to make of that only,  
127 ah, I think you may have said you might have heard, have you  
128 heard that he was selling some of his marijuana or, or is that just an  
129 assumption that you're making

130 **R.NOLAN:** I heard

131 **CST. NIPPARD:** Okay, just from hearsay

132 **R.NOLAN:** I can't prove it

133 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

134 **R.NOLAN:** It's only hearsay

135 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yes, yeah, gotcha, small community, you hear things right

136 **R.NOLAN:** Yeah. He got nothing to do with me, I had nothing to do with him,  
137 say hello if I met him at the store, how are ya, whatever

138 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

139 **R.NOLAN:** And that was it, other than that I never see him, I never met him,  
140 wave if I'm passing by, driving along and that was it

141 **CST. NIPPARD:** Now you told me about, ah, you said he has a couple of siblings  
142 right, a couple of brothers

143 **R.NOLAN:** I know he has Dick DUNPHY and I know he has another brother up  
144 on the Nine Mile Road

145 **CST. NIPPARD:** Where would that be

146 **R.NOLAN:** Colinet Road, we'll say, just turn up there by the gas station

147 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

148 **R.NOLAN:** Ah, I can't even remember his name, I don't know how many more  
149 he has

150 **CST. NIPPARD:** Okay, that's just the ones you know for

151 **R.NOLAN:** Yeah

152 **CST. NIPPARD:** Now you said, ah, what happened today with Megan finding out, I  
153 can't remember what you were saying, you were saying that more  
154 or less Megan...

155 **R.NOLAN:** Megan knew nothing

156 **CST. NIPPARD:** Okay

157 **R.NOLAN:** The girl, a friend of hers

158 **CST. NIPPARD:** M'hmm

159 **R.NOLAN:** She worked with at the store, at North Atlantic

160 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

161 **R.NOLAN:** Texted her and said what's on the go at your Dad's, there's a lot of  
162 cops, ah, she never got back to her so by the time they got here,  
163 she said Rochelle, Megan never got back to me, I don't even know  
164 if Megan knows

165 **CST. NIPPARD:** Who was that friend, obviously you know her or something

166 **R.NOLAN:** Yeah

167 **CST. NIPPARD:** Okay

168 **R.NOLAN:** Ahm, Trina [REDACTED]

169 **CST. NIPPARD:** Trina [REDACTED]

170 **R.NOLAN:** Yeah

171 **CST. NIPPARD:** Okay, she's just a friend of Megan's that works with Megan at the  
172 store

173 **R.NOLAN:** She worked with Megan a few years back

174 **CST. NIPPARD:** Oh, okay, she doesn't work with her anymore

175 **R.NOLAN:** No, no

176 **CST. NIPPARD:** Okay but she's a friend of Megan's is she

177 **R.NOLAN:** Yeah, yeah

178 **CST. NIPPARD:** Okay

179 **R.NOLAN:** Or associate or whatever you may call her

180 **CST. NIPPARD:** Okay, yeah

181 **R.NOLAN:** Anyway

182 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

183 **R.NOLAN:** She said, ah, when she got here she said Rochelle what am I  
184 supposed to do, she said, I don't even know if Megan knows, I said  
185 Trina just call her and tell her, Megan, cause we were after hearing  
186 through VPCM that there was multiple shootings in Mount Carmel,  
187 one man dead, I said don't tell her nothing, just tell her there's a lot  
188 of cops and ambulances at her Dad's, I think you should come  
189 down and apparently when she called her, she knew nothing about  
190 it and said what's on the go, she, I think, don't know, wasn't talking  
191 to her, never heard it but only hearsay again, everything is hearsay

192 **CST. NIPPARD:** M'hmm

193 **R.NOLAN:** Ah, if he's caught for marijuana it's no big deal, like, but what's on  
194 the go, why is the ambulance there, ah, after that she said Megan  
195 you should just come down, so apparently Megan stopped an  
196 RCMP officer on the Salmonier Line and said I'm going with you,  
197 you're on my way to my Dad's and she got a ride down with the  
198 RCMP officer

199 **CST. NIPPARD:** Okay

200 **R.NOLAN:** And that's when she found out and apparently, I do believe, she  
201 was told that Megan had said if my Dad, when she got down here  
202 and find, found out what was after happening, if my Dad was shot,  
203 somebody shot him cause my Dad don't even own a gun

204 **CST. NIPPARD:** Oh, okay

205 **R.NOLAN:** According to Megan

206 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

207 **R.NOLAN:** She knew nothing about a gun

208 **CST. NIPPARD:** Oh, okay

209 **R.NOLAN:** So any more than that, I don't know

210 **CST. NIPPARD:** Okay

211 **R.NOLAN:** But after hearing through several others, yes, there was a gun in the  
212 house, truth, I don't know, like I said, I had no dealings with the man

213 **CST. NIPPARD:** Ah, (unintelligible) the black SUV you were talking about earlier,  
214 those, that was down in front of your house here, tell me about that  
215 again

216 **R.NOLAN:** It kind of looked like a pick-up with a black box on it, my son looked  
217 out and said, Mom, who's parked down in front of the house, (phone

218 ringing) one moment, call you back, ah, no it's probably off the  
219 hook, RCMP are here I got to call you back, bye, ah, my son looked  
220 out the window and said Mom who's parked down on the road, I  
221 said I don't know and when I looked it was a black, looked like a  
222 pick-up with a black truck on it, ■ said it was an SUV

223 **CST. NIPPARD:** M'hmm

224 **R.NOLAN:** He said Mom that's an undercover cop, I said what, we were just  
225 finishing up dinner, just starting to clean up from dinner, ah, I said  
226 ■ that's not a cop, he had a, it looked to be like he had a big cat  
227 on, cap on and he said Mom I'm telling ya, that's an undercover  
228 cop, I said ■ how do you know it's an undercover cop, he said  
229 Mom, I'm back and forth to CBS ten times a week, I can tell ya it's  
230 an undercover cop, you can tell by the wheels, I said oh, okay,  
231 whatever, it meant nothing to me, I just thought it was somebody on  
232 their cell phone but that's what he said

233 **CST. NIPPARD:** Around what time was that

234 **R.NOLAN:** That was around, we sat to dinner around quarter to one, that was  
235 around twenty after one I'm gonna say, to be safe, say between one  
236 and one thirty

237 **CST. NIPPARD:** How long was he parked down there

238 **R.NOLAN:** Five to seven minutes

239 **CST. NIPPARD:** Oh, okay. Was he facing this way or this way, facing that way was  
240 he, okay

241 **R.NOLAN:** Yeah, up the road

242 **CST. NIPPARD:** Did you, you said you thought he was on his cell phone, did you see  
243 that he was on his cell phone

244 **R.NOLAN:** No, I just assumed, he was stopped on the road

245 **CST. NIPPARD:** Okay

246 **R.NOLAN:** Talking on the phone

247 **CST. NIPPARD:** Oh he was talking on the phone was he

248 **R.NOLAN:** No, I just assumed

249 **CST. NIPPARD:** Oh, oh, okay

250 **R.NOLAN:** That's why he was stopped

251 **CST. NIPPARD:** Alright, did he get out of the car at all

252 **R.NOLAN:** No

253 **CST. NIPPARD:** No, okay

254 **R.NOLAN:** When he was stopped down there he never got out of the car

255 **█ NOLAN:** No he never got out of the car but he was looking for something in  
256 the car

257 **R.NOLAN:** Yeah, but...

258 **CST. NIPPARD:** That's fine, now earlier, ah, I mean, you guys obviously know there  
259 was gun shots fired but, ah, I know you said earlier you didn't hear  
260 anything at any point

261 **R.NOLAN:** Never heard a thing, I had myself and my Mom, my two boys, my  
262 oldest boy's girlfriend, her brother, my daughter, her common-law,  
263 their two children, TV was going, fan was going, dinner was on the  
264 go, I heard nothing, I was blown away when somebody called and  
265 said what's on the go, when █ called and said Mom there's  
266 something on the go cause I just met two or three cop cars flying  
267 down the Salmonier Line with the lights blaring and sirens going

268 **CST. NIPPARD:** M'hmm

269 **R.NOLAN:** And that's when I said must be something on the go down in St.  
270 Mary's probably or North Harbour, Colinet, Branch somewhere,  
271 never thinking it was next door, when I saw 'em stop just over the  
272 road and back up, I'm thinking oh my god, never, never, never,  
273 never thinking

274 **CST. NIPPARD:** M'hmm

275 **R.NOLAN:** It was right next door to me, whatever was going on, didn't know  
276 nothing at that point but never, never thinking that it was gonna be  
277 right next door to me and when I found out what had happened

278 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

279 **R.NOLAN:** I was mortified

280 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

281 **R.NOLAN:** And then it said on VOXM that somebody called and said it just said  
282 on VOXM that shooter, the shooter was still at large and I'm  
283 thinking, what, lock your door, the shooter is still at large, so I  
284 locked my door

285 **[REDACTED].NOLAN:** Got me to check the garage first

286 **R.NOLAN:** Well I got [REDACTED] to check the garage first, cause, kind of with the  
287 broken ankle, I couldn't get out and check it but I was watching him,  
288 to make sure it was locked, ah, I went out, I sat on the chair,  
289 brought a knife out with me (laughs)

290 **CST. NIPPARD:** (Laughs)

291 **R.NOLAN:** Cause if it's somebody coming in, they ain't getting in without a fight

292 **CST. NIPPARD:** (Laughs) Didn't know at that point I guess

293 **R.NOLAN:** Oh my god, my nerves were gone

294 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

295 **R.NOLAN:** My, I kid you not, I mean I had an eighty year old Mom

296 **CST. NIPPARD:** M'hmm

297 **R.NOLAN:** And my son here

298 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

299 **R.NOLAN:** But sent me out to the garage

300 **R.NOLAN:** No, no

301 **R.NOLAN:** You sent me to the garage with no idea what was going on

302 **R.NOLAN:** I was watching, listen, broken ankle or not, I was watchin' ya, I'd  
303 have come at them like spider monkeys sweetheart

304 **CST. NIPPARD:** (Laughs)

305 **R.NOLAN:** But, yeah, I sat next to the door with the knife on the table and I'm  
306 not a violent person

307 **CST. NIPPARD:** No

308 **R.NOLAN:** But they ain't getting' in without a fight, sorry

309 **CST. NIPPARD:** I hear ya, now you said he was, you said he got hurt when he was  
310 working with Highways and he was on Worker's Compensation ever  
311 since, do you know how long ago that was

312 **R.NOLAN:** Oh my god, that was...

313 **CST. NIPPARD:** And what happened

314 **R.NOLAN:** I think he got squat, I heard something about getting squat between  
315 two trucks

316 **CST. NIPPARD:** Oh, okay

317 **R.NOLAN:** Got his back really screwed up, now sweetheart you could be  
318 asking the wrong person because

319 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

320 **R.NOLAN:** Somebody in the community would know a whole lot more about  
321 that than me

322 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah, you don't know how long ago that was, do ya

323 **R.NOLAN:** I'm gonna say it's over twenty years ago or actually, I'm, yeah I'm  
324 gonna say twenty years ago because we were living up by, what  
325 they call, Rattlin' Brook when he was driving the snow plow and  
326 struck a pothole, hit the guard rail and landed it out over the  
327 guardrail five o'clock in the morning, right in front of my house, way  
328 up the road so...yeah

329 **CST. NIPPARD:** Now what was it about this sign you guys were mentioning over at  
330 his house

331 **R.NOLAN:** [REDACTED] went up the road

332 **[REDACTED].NOLAN:** For a walk, ah, a couple of days ago and, ah, when I was walking  
333 back, I noticed, something caught my eye when I was walking, I  
334 looked over to see what it was and all I see was a sign I had never  
335 seen up there before, all I could make out on it, on it was, it was a  
336 warning do not enter I think

337 **R.NOLAN:** Yeah, can you let him out

338 **[REDACTED].NOLAN:** I just did

339 **R.NOLAN:** He got to go out again

340 **CST. NIPPARD:** You were saying something about government officials or  
341 something like that, where did that come from

342 **R.NOLAN:** I heard he was sending threatening letters to government

343 **CST. NIPPARD:** Oh, okay

344 **R.NOLAN:** And apparently that's what the ongoing investigation was supposed  
345 to be about

346 **CST. NIPPARD:** Oh, okay

347 **R.NOLAN:** And again

348 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

349 **R.NOLAN:** It's only what I'm after hearing

350 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yes, yeah

351 **R.NOLAN:** Are you sure you don't want a drink

352 **CST. NIPPARD:** Oh, I'm good

353 **R.NOLAN:** Water

354 **CST. NIPPARD:** I'm good, yes

355 **R.NOLAN:** Tea, coffee

356 **CST. NIPPARD:** I'm good my darling, thank you, just trying to remember if there's  
357 anything else we didn't talk about already, that we had spoke about.  
358 I know you were saying that he was, ah, a loner over there, he,  
359 since his wife died, do you remember what her name was

360 **R.NOLAN:** I'm thinking it was Debbie

361 **CST. NIPPARD:** Oh, same thing as his sister-in-law

362 **R.NOLAN:** I, I think, don't quote me

363 **CST. NIPPARD:** Okay

364 **R.NOLAN:** I was only new on the scene

365 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

366 **R.NOLAN:** When she passed away

367 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah and he hasn't been with another woman there or living with  
368 anybody else over there since

369 **R.NOLAN:** No

370 **CST. NIPPARD:** No

371 **R.NOLAN:** No never

372 **CST. NIPPARD:** Do you know if Megan was close with him, or...

373 **R.NOLAN:** I...

374 **█NOLAN:** I don't think she was that close with him

375 **R.NOLAN:** Not, she wasn't there every day but

376 **█NOLAN:** I'd say (Unintelligible)

377 **R.NOLAN:** I think she was Daddy's girl

378 **CST. NIPPARD:** Do you know who, if he had any real, like, close friends that came  
379 by often

380 **R.NOLAN:** Oh my god, I wouldn't be able to tell ya

381 **CST. NIPPARD:** No

382 **R.NOLAN:** I haven't got a clue

383 **CST. NIPPARD:** Or anybody that you know, that he spoke with on a regular basis or  
384 anything like that, no

385 **R.NOLAN:** Have no idea

386 **CST. NIPPARD:** Did he ever go, go very far from the door

387 **R.NOLAN:** I wouldn't be able to tell ya

388 **CST. NIPPARD:** No

389 **.NOLAN:** I was walking, I heard him walking around (unintelligible) but I heard  
390 him walking somewhere from his house

391 **R.NOLAN:** Yeah around the house or doing work, doing whatever he was  
392 doing over there, I would never even, if I walked by the house, I  
393 wouldn't even turn my head

394 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

395 **R.NOLAN:** I'd just keep on going

396 **CST. NIPPARD:** Does he have a vehicle

397 **R.NOLAN:** Yeah

398 **CST. NIPPARD:** Oh, okay, that he drove, like, it was working

399 **R.NOLAN:** Yeah

400 **CST. NIPPARD:** Drove it (unintelligible), okay

401 **R.NOLAN:** Yeah

402 **CST. NIPPARD:** Do you know why he was apparently sending these threatening  
403 letters to the government or what they were about or anything like  
404 that, or through hearsay obviously

405 **R.NOLAN:** All I knows, I'm after hearing it on open line

406 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

407 **R.NOLAN:** And whatever that he personally didn't think that he was being  
408 compensated enough to pay for his living expenses basically

409 **CST. NIPPARD:** Now if you've been here for twelve years, do you know when  
410 Megan moved out from living with him, how long ago was that

411 **R.NOLAN:** Ah, I'm gonna say probably five years ago, six years ago. Let him  
412 in, please.

413 **.NOLAN:** M'hmm

414 **CST. NIPPARD:** You said he didn't have, ah, he doesn't have much to do with his  
415 brother next door there at all hey

416 **R.NOLAN:** Oh...

417 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

418 **R.NOLAN:** I know him and his sister-in-law

419 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

420 **R.NOLAN:** Dick's wife

421 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah, Debbie

422 **R.NOLAN:** Never got along, at all

423 **CST. NIPPARD:** Do you know why

424 **R.NOLAN:** Apparently, she blamed him for killing her flower garden which was  
425 a big flower garden

426 **CST. NIPPARD:** Okay

427 **R.NOLAN:** Other than that I have no clue, what

428 **.NOLAN:** Ahm, when me and Chad walked over to talk to her, ahm, she said  
429 at the summer he would always go over and break her trees and kill  
430 her flowers

431 **R.NOLAN:** Yeah her flower garden and well after coming after a nine or a ten  
432 year old, five, six years back I think there was a little bit of par,  
433 paranoia set in

434 **CST. NIPPARD:** With regards to him

435 **R.NOLAN:** Yeah

436 **CST. NIPPARD:** Paranoia with regards to what, said ten years ago you say

437 **R.NOLAN:** No, no

438 **CST. NIPPARD:** Oh, sorry

439 **R.NOLAN:** When he come after my child

440 **CST. NIPPARD:** Oh, okay

441 **R.NOLAN:** About the kitten

442 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

443 **R.NOLAN:** I think he was just basically paranoid

444 **CST. NIPPARD:** Oh, okay, okay

445 **R.NOLAN:** Not sure

446 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

447 **R.NOLAN:** That's only my thoughts

448 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah, what do you think he's paranoid about, like, you were saying  
449 earlier that you thought he had some issues, what do you

450 **R.NOLAN:** Mmmm, I think it was just too much drugs in the system

451 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

452 **R.NOLAN:** That made him paranoid

453 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

454 **R.NOLAN:** Debbie said he was unstable, that's why she thought the cops were  
455 there to take him to the (unintelligible) or something

456 **R.NOLAN:** Yeah

457 **CST. NIPPARD:** Have you heard if he's done any other drugs besides marijuana

458 **R.NOLAN:** No

459 **CST. NIPPARD:** No, okay. Did he ever do anything, like, ah, that was weird that you  
460 know just stood out, I know when you're in a small town sometimes  
461 if somebody's like that or a loner like you say they do things that  
462 make you look or think...

463 **R.NOLAN:** The only thing that stood out was when he came after my young  
464 fella, after a kitten

465 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah, yeah

466 **R.NOLAN:** Other than that, he was a loner

467 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

468 **R.NOLAN:** To me

469 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

470 **R.NOLAN:** He was a loner

471 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

472 **R.NOLAN:** There was no, I don't think there was any companionship after his  
473 wife passed away

474 **CST. NIPPARD:** M'hmm

475 **R.NOLAN:** Ah, other than that, no, none

476 **CST. NIPPARD:** Okay. Did you take him for somebody who could be violent?

477 **R.NOLAN:** Ah, when he came, when I went over to speak with him

478 **CST. NIPPARD:** M'hmm

479 **R.NOLAN:** About coming, scaring the crap out of my oldest son, ah, when he  
480 came face to face with me

481 **CST. NIPPARD:** M'hmm

482 **R.NOLAN:** Literally face to face, I'm thinking, yeah, I warned my children not to  
483 go handy because I'm thinking...

484 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

485 **[REDACTED].NOLAN:** He could lose it at any time

486 **R.NOLAN:** He's burnt

487 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

488 **R.NOLAN:** I'm thinking there's that much drugs into his system that he's  
489 probably paranoid

490 **[REDACTED].NOLAN:** And he was if he put a warning up on his house

491 **R.NOLAN:** Well, yeah

492 **CST. NIPPARD:** Alright, is there anything else you can think to talk about that we  
493 didn't already talk about

494 **R.NOLAN:** Not a thing

495 **CST. NIPPARD:** No?

496 **R.NOLAN:** I can't offer you nothing

497 **CST. NIPPARD:** No

498 **R.NOLAN:** If you asks me and I...

499 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yes, yeah

500 **R.NOLAN:** Thinks I knows

501 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yes, that's all you can do

502 **R.NOLAN:** I can try and answer 'em

503 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

504 **R.NOLAN:** But for me to come out and tell ya

505 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

506 **R.NOLAN:** I haven't got a clue

507 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

508 **R.NOLAN:** Only what we're already after covering

509 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah, most everybody in the community I guess would know him or  
510 know of him

511 **R.NOLAN:** Oh

512 **CST. NIPPARD:** At least anyway right

513 **R.NOLAN:** A whole lot better than me

514 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah, yeah

515 **R.NOLAN:** A whole lot better than I can

516 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah, he likes me

517 **R.NOLAN:** I think he likes ya

518 **CST. NIPPARD:** Or he smells my dog

519 **R.NOLAN:** You want to take him home

520 **CST. NIPPARD:** Sure, I'll take him, no problem, alright

521 **R.NOLAN:** He'll let you know when there's anybody at the door

522 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah, that's good though, you need that

523 **R.NOLAN:** Yeah

524 **CST. NIPPARD:** Alright I think that's, I think that's all I can ask, or think to ask ya,  
525 you didn't, ah, you didn't hear anything over there, how long was it,

526 would you think between when you seen the SUV down in front and  
527 when you seen police cars end up over there, how long was it in  
528 between that time

529 **R.NOLAN:** I'm gonna say an hour and a half

530 **CST. NIPPARD:** Okay

531 **R.NOLAN:** Because by the time [REDACTED] let his dinner settle and whatever

532 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

533 **R.NOLAN:** And left to go to CBS and got out by the big tower on the Salmonier  
534 Line and called and said, ah, Mom, something on the go in the bay

535 **CST. NIPPARD:** M'hmm

536 **R.NOLAN:** I just met two or three cop cars with the lights, sirens going

537 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

538 **R.NOLAN:** And they're gone flat out, so I'm gonna say an hour, hour and a half

539 **CST. NIPPARD:** You said [REDACTED] or [REDACTED] what does he go...

540 **R.NOLAN:** [REDACTED]

541 **CST. NIPPARD:** [REDACTED] yeah

542 **R.NOLAN:** And he stopped and called probably...

543 **CST. NIPPARD:** What, ah, so they called your, that phone, did he call that phone

544 **R.NOLAN:** Yes

545 **CST. NIPPARD:** Maybe get a, if you could get a time

546 **R.NOLAN:** I think (beeping sound), my god

547 **CST. NIPPARD:** (Laughs) Lots of calls

548 **R.NOLAN:** Oh my god

549 **█.NOLAN:** The phone never stopped

550 **R.NOLAN:** It never stopped

551 **█.NOLAN:** Come on baby, come up

552 **R.NOLAN:** I had my grandchildren here and I was trying to enjoy their time

553 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

554 **R.NOLAN:** But the phone never stopped, yeah, that's how many calls it was

555 **█.NOLAN:** Are you sure he didn't call your cell phone

556 **R.NOLAN:** No I think he called the house, what's today, sixth

557 **█.NOLAN:** April fifth

558 **R.NOLAN:** Fifth, okay I'm still on the fifth and I'm still going through 'em

559 **CST. NIPPARD:** (Laughs)

560 **R.NOLAN:** And I'm only back to four thirty

561 **█.NOLAN:** It's been a long day

562 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

563 **R.NOLAN:** It may not go back that far actually

564 **█.NOLAN:** Check your cell phone

565 **R.NOLAN:** Hang on babe, it's not going back that far

566 **CST. NIPPARD:** Oh, no

567 **R.NOLAN:** No, unbelievable, like, you wouldn't believe it, you can check it

568 yourself

569 **CST. NIPPARD:** Maybe it was your cell phone or do you know, or, can you  
570 remember, probably not if you had the phone up to your head that  
571 many times, hey

572 **R.NOLAN:** I kid you not, it was, I was addled

573 **CST. NIPPARD:** Crazy

574 **█.NOLAN:** I would say it was around, it was on Renee's phone, you realize that  
575 right, it was Renee's phone number, you never changed the new  
576 phone

577 **R.NOLAN:** Wait now

578 **█.NOLAN:** No, it was on that phone, cause I can remember, I see it

579 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah it only goes back as far as three oh, three oh two

580 **R.NOLAN:** Yeah

581 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

582 **R.NOLAN:** I'm not joking

583 **CST. NIPPARD:** You had that many calls

584 **R.NOLAN:** The phone haven't stopped

585 **█.NOLAN:** I would say it was around...

586 **R.NOLAN:** From people that don't even call me

587 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah of course, it's just cause they know you live next door

588 **R.NOLAN:** Ah, yeah

589 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah, well if it was an hour and a half, I guess it would have been...

590 **R.NOLAN:** I'm gonna say

591 **CST. NIPPARD:** You said it was twelve thirty for the car right

592 **R.NOLAN:** Well it was around twelve thirty, one o'clock we saw the

593 **CST. NIPPARD:** Oh no, one thirty, one thirty you said

594 **R.NOLAN:** Yeah

595 **CST. NIPPARD:** Twenty after one, one thirty yeah

596 **R.NOLAN:** Yeah, so I'm gonna say it was two thirty, three o'clock

597 **CST. NIPPARD:** Okay

598 **[REDACTED].NOLAN:** Is that sis' new number

599 **R.NOLAN:** No that's sissy's number

600 **[REDACTED].NOLAN:** Okay, that's...

601 **R.NOLAN:** Check the other phone actually

602 **[REDACTED].NOLAN:** Yeah it was on the other phone

603 **R.NOLAN:** Yeah it was on the other phone

604 **CST. NIPPARD:** What's that

605 **R.NOLAN:** When the phone call came in

606 **CST. NIPPARD:** I guess the calls are still coming, calls would still come through on  
607 both phones wouldn't it

608 **R.NOLAN:** No cause that one was dead

609 **CST. NIPPARD:** Oh, I gotcha

610 **R.NOLAN:** Yeah, it's been a crazy day

611 **CST. NIPPARD:** Yeah

612 **[REDACTED].NOLAN:** Yet all the calls still managed to go through on a dead phone

613 **R.NOLAN:** Two forty seven actually

614 **CST. NIPPARD:** Two forty seven

615 **R.NOLAN:** Yeah, I do believe

616 **[REDACTED].NOLAN:** I knew it was around two fifty, two forty sometime

617 **R.NOLAN:** I think it was two forty seven [REDACTED] called and said he saw, met the  
618 cops on the line

619 **CST. NIPPARD:** Alright, so the time is now eight o'clock, eight oh two, stop that
