Meghan DUNPHY calls, enquiring when someone would come down to retrieve her father's glasses. I told her that I would leave in 5 minutes, and meet her at the house. She said that her father's glasses are beat up, and that they are held together with tape. She said that he was wearing those glasses when they went to the Woodstock, and that they were not beat up at that time. She said there was no tape on them at that time. I asked her if her father had a second pair of glasses, and she said no.

15:05

Meet Meghan and Billy CORCORAN at the DUNPHY res. The house has been cleaned up, and there is a pile of household items on the front lawn.

Meghan shows me the glasses, which are on the table, directly in front of Don DUNPHY's recliner. The glasses are in very poor condition, and are being held together by white medical tape. One of the lenses is falling out, and is being held in by the tape. Both ear pieces have tape at the end, in place of the plastic sleeves, which would sit on the ears. One of the nose pads is missing, and is sitting next to the glasses. The glasses are very dirty, with rust spots, and green "mould", which sometimes forms on glasses. The white tape is dirty, and appears to have been on the glasses for some time. The glasses were found laying flat on the table, with both arms at right angles to their normal position, as if someone stepped on them, sat on them, or something was laid on top of them.

The glasses were seized, as well as the nose pad.
