Hey guys,

I went over this document, with regards to the exhibits. Most of the exhibits, which RIOUX suggests be sent to the lab, have already been sent off. There are, however, three items that were not sent. They are as follows:

- 1. clothing of the deceased for GSR pattern.
- 2. GSR kits from the autopsy
- 3. ammunition from the rifle

In reviewing Cst. NIPPARD's correspondence with Sqt. Mike MERRITT, from the lab, two of these items were addressed. Here is what Sgt. MERRITT had to say:

- 1. Unfortunately, the lab can't approve the deceased's clothing for GSR, because he was shot, and finding GSR on his clothing is inevitable, and therefore not probative
- 2. Unfortunately, GSR samples from a shooting victim aren't examined. The reason being that someone who is shot will undoubtably be contaminated with GSR, and Trace Evidence can't differentiate between the GSR from one firearm to another

With regards to DUNPHY's clothing, both of his shirts were sent off. Not for GSR testing, but for bullet trajectory testing.

The live .22 rounds that were seized were not mentioned in the C-414, nor by Sqt. MERRITT.
