This was an issued encountered today by Cst K Burse in Corner Brook and he called me to assist him. I met with IMD staff as I could not get the additional hits to show using RMS persons query. Staff made several attempts before figuring out that the FIP and CFRO fields had to be changed from the default "YES" to being left blank before the additional hits would display. Is this something that could be corrected as the additional hits are most often more important than FIP and CFRO, especially now that the national gun registry has been essentially dismantled.




