1137 AM → S/Sgt. Kent Osmond calls me to advise that he is very concerned about Joe Smyth's well being. Supt Joe Smyth contacted him to say "I want to know up. I want to speak to you about Liche. This is breaking me. He has dementia."

Osmond is the lead on the Donald Dunphy shooting for the agency. Supt that he has spoken to Joe and his wife when he advised of the outcome of ASIRT review. Supt his wife is concerned about Joe's well being.

Osmond reiterates that he is concerned about Joe's mindset and is very worried about him. Supt we need to intervene and take care of him.

Supt the Kemp didn't disclose the details

Sept 21/16 Continued

I advised Justice Riche's Report as they didn't agree with it. They (Penny) thought it would be disclosed during the inquiry when crown and defense could cross examine Riche on his thoughts/report.

I asked Osmond how Judge Riche could say that Smyth was an angry man. Discussed Cst. Steve Burke reviewing Smyth's professional standards file. Supt Burke wrote notes from the file.

1124 AM - late Sat. morn.

Just off phone when Osmond called. Work above work before this one.

1124 AM. I sent email to S/Sgt. Grant Little of Saskatoon P.S. regarding the delivery of his report on internal investigation. Within minute Little called me to advise that the report went into paralegal courier on Monday, addressed to Chief Jones with me as a contact if any problem. expect it to be delivered any day.

Supt there are no breaches of any policy procedures or regulations. 9 page report. This' only fault is that Joe Smyth should not have wrote that letter to the RAC membership which was leaked to the media.

We discussed his retirement effective next week.

Sept 21, 2016 Continued

immediately to see D/C Singleton after I spoke to Sgt. Osmond approx 1150 am. then to see chief with DCS.

I expressed concern regarding Joe Smyth. He sent me an email last night saying he wanted to crawl into a big hole, today he is sending request to Osmond expressing stress. And Osmond is concerned. Justice Riche's comments are inflaming the situation for Smyth who has been exonerated by both RICHY and ASIANT.

17358 We discussed issue of media release. DCS drafted same. During this time chief called Insp. Sean O'Reilly to meeting as he is a manager with extensive EAP and peer training. He will reach out to Joe Smyth.

200pm I discovered email from Joe Smyth sent at 1040 am to chief, Joe Gallege, Mike Summers and Counsel John Dwyer.

Smyth obviously stressed over Riche's comments and says this situation is "Breaking him". That Riche is making him out to be an "anger fuelled Cowboy" and requesting that "Somebody speak for me."

November 8, Tuesday

1243 pm

Joe Smith called me to advise that the release of the DD investigations by RCMP, Sinc. Alberta, and Saskatoon are not being released this afternoon as scheduled.

He received notification from the RCMP of follow-up investigation required and it is on the news.

I have no idea of any of this.

1245 pm

Called D.C. Sigher. He was just advised by Wendy 2. of the same. He does not have any further info.

139 pm

I called Joe back to advise that I inquired of DES who has no additional info.

Joe says apparently that an anonymous letter was sent to the Inquiry Lawyers and has been referred to RCMP for follow-up.
