RE: Initiative for restructuring of Protective Service Detail

Sir;

Please find outlined below some initiatives for the restructuring of Protective Service Detail.


- Members assigned to the Protective Service Detail be reassigned back to regular duties with the respective forces effective Sunday, February 14th, 2016.
- All complaints of threats on perceived threats received against the Premier or Provincial Cabinet Minister by phone or email shall be forwarded to the liaison person in the Premier Office who will then forward the complaint to the Intelligence and Organized Crime Unit of the RNC for action.
- Members of the Intelligence and Organized Crime Unit will review all complaints received and forwarded to the force of jurisdiction for threat assessment and action. RNC Intelligence file will be opened on all complaints reviewed.
- Once the threat assessment is completed the O I/C of Intelligence and Organized Crime shall be notified when the threat level is considered to be medium to high.
- The O I/C of Intelligence and Organized Crime will discuss all threats considered minimum to high with the Chief of Staff for the Premier to determine whether a security detail should be assigned to the Premier to deal with the threat in question.
- Member of the Intelligence and Organized Crime along with RNC social media contacts will closely monitor all social media site for any special threats noticed on Facebook, Twitter, etc and will notify Intelligence and Organize Crime immediately of any concerns.
 - Members will only be assigned to travel with the Premier or other government officials in circumstances where the threat level to the government official is high.
 - Threats to government officials will be addressed in a separate line item in the Intelligence and Organized Crime Quarterly Report but will be monitored on a daily and weekly basis.

All vehicles, radio, computers, blackberries, files and other special protective service

items shall be property itemized and returned to Intelligence and Organized Crime Section for storage.

The initiative shall be monitored on a daily, weekly and monthly basis and adjusted if required.
