20:45 On scene - Mount Carmel - main road, part  
west / technically Mitchell's Brook.

Numerous members on scene in marked units  
Cpl. Trevor O'Keefe, Sgt. Steve Conahan. Ucal members  
Burt: Henstridge in unmarked unit. Add'l patrol  
units present.

Residence on steep roadside, opposite water.  
Rural area, sparsely populated.

- Walk Through - Cpl. Foster inside residence -  
necessary due to number of cats.

- residence and property in poor condition. Access  
through front door, no proper steps -  
wooden piece on block, old tire rim.  
- garbage, junk, dozens of cats.

- inside - residence in state of decay. Cats everywhere.  
Living room to right of front entrance, deceased  
in seated position + recliner, rifle at his  
feet.

- Wounds visible
- no pt significant blood pattern in room
- items strewn about living room
- remainder of house - kitchen beyond, room off kitchen with small marijuana grow
- other rooms - closed to keep cats in, away from deceased.
- limited exterior photos / video due to darkness.
- Phot / video of interior - living room area (Sgt. Sunden's photo, no video).
- remainder of house to wait until body removed.
- Sgt. Sunden placed placards on items - re-photos, video done with placards in place.
- rifle, live round in table, void in debris on floor, cell phone on table, Abler on table, four shell casing, on floor, bat / stick,

- hole in wall beyond position of deceased's head.  
- saw through into entry way, not front wall corner.

- 3 wounds apparent on deceased - 2 head, one arm. Not examined closely - at autopsy.

- measurements taken of living room with furniture, window, deceased

- photos taken of hole in wall, could not pass through and to trajectory.

- Sgt Saunders consulted in NFIS as per policy - Sgt Adrian Butler - no attendance required.

- Funeral home removed body

- items of window collected and stored - Cr. Galway.

03:15 at HQ to sleep.

05:30 Start day - brief meet with NCU - no  
new development.

Get Sander & autopsy at 11:00, see to  
scene.

11:40 Back on scene - video, further measurements,  
further photo, examination of wall for  
projectile.

- marked unit maintaining same security  
(Grant van, plus one additional PC).

14:00 Finished additional video - exterior, interior rooms.  
- small back room leading to back porch - hall door  
had been closed - extreme condition  
- 2 rooms on other side of hall - room with  
marijuana plants growing, and room bathroom.  
- all video recorded.


- snack break.

14:30 began measurements.

16:15 Completed interior measurements.

18:35 Trajectory analysis

- trajectory red through walls -  
10° angle




- used rods, laser to point at spot on far wall. Used string, then angle finder to determine angle down.


- measurements - laser intersect point on wall above couch:

- projectile projectile entered wall beyond radiator, passed through a stud - struck wall to side of front door.

19:45 Received 2 containers with bullets for  
Sgt Saunders, departed scene.

20:00 - on highway.

22:00 Back in Clareville. burning photos, unloading  
equipment, secured exhibits. 22:30 - left office.

- At scene: following trajectory analysis -  
drywall removed from wall around hole "D"  
, 40 calibre <sup>(?)</sup> bullet found near floor - Sgt. Saunders  
had heard an object fall previous day,  
while examining hole.

- slit fabric on back of recliner - near hole  
"A" (hole in fabric), 40 calibre (?) bullet found  
in stitching of chair, near surface.

- bullets collected  
- collected piece of skull from floor just beyond  
recliner, break hole "B" roughly - for  
placement purposes.

-moved couch and recliner - nothing further.

09:25 At autopsy room (arrived 08:45). Dr. Aris,

- body bag opened - Daniel Reid placed bag  
on hands until GSK<sup>kit</sup> could be collected.

09:45 Cst Pat Hickey - ANC - delivered 2 sealed GSK<sup>new</sup>  
kit. Did not enter autopsy room or office.  
- X-ray in room

09:55 GSK kit collected - hands: free.  
- took thumbprint of Cst Conway.  
- Sgt Saunders confirmed 10-Print Fetal available

13:30 finished

Cst Conway, Cpt. Seaward, Dr. Aris -  
no issues outstanding & require scene to

13:05 - Sgt Osmond on scene as observer - retired judge/justice?

- Joe Smyth & Bill James on scene. Video started as per recording.

14:18 Completed. Scene vacated.

- 11:00 At office - downloading Pinnacle - video from Sony and Canon - Canon footage did not import - footage lost - Sgt. Saunders advised. Tech Crime to assist.
- 11:30 Departed for St. John's with CPU and camera.
- 13:30 Tech Crime - Sgt. Fidler. Attempts to recover from memory card, CPU.
- 15:40 Advised Cpl. Burke of issue.
- 16:18 - CPU left at Tech Crime - Heph Fidler will image same, work from image. CPU can be returned when image complete.
- 17:10 - attempts to contact Nott for imaging unsuccessful.

08:15 rifle into CA chamber. Visual exam prior - neg.  
- after CA - no visible development.

10:15 Ardrox - in sink to dry.

11:15 examined with FLS - neg for friction ridge impressions

- rifle boxed up in pre-FLS 10x gun box, to  
be delivered to H&M.

12:20 - Est. Sinclair advise re-do of re-environment this  
afternoon ASAP. Collected gear, checked equipment.

12:40 Cpl. Burke called - asked could I be in Mitchell's  
Brook to 15:00. Advised I would be there.

14:30 On scene Mitchell's Brook. Retired Justice David Rice  
already present. Sgt. Tiller present. Checked house.

Also attending: Sgt. Ormond, Cpl. Hendricks,  
Cpl. Burke, Inspector Cahill.

RNC Inspector Jason Sheppard came to site.

15:00 Joe Smyth and fellow RNC officer Tim Buckle  
arrived. Video commenced shortly thereafter.

Cpl. Hendricks recorded with 2nd hand up camera.

15:57 departed scene.

-Went to Holywood detachment.

16:45 - Secured rifle in temp locker with Holywood padlock. Left note with time/date on locker, advised Sgt Tiller. Left not for Cpl. Seaward.

- While at Holywood, checked video. All recorded. Note - toward end of re-enactment, camera microphone battery failed. Was monitoring sound a headphones, pulled cord for mic immediately and relied a built in mic for remainder. Sound quality will be diminished for this segment.
