RE: RNC Member Involved Shooting (Dunphy) - Investigation Overview


I am writing to provide an overview of the investigation into the fatal shooting of Mr. Donald Dunphy on April 5th, 2015. As we know, this matter is of considerable interest to the public and it is for that reason I am providing this overview.

Investigation to Date:

- All statements and/or interviews have been completed
- All exhibits have been processed and/or analyzed
- Laboratory services have been completed
- All investigative material has been forwarded to the independent observer, retired Justice Riche

Current Investigation Activity:

- An external Use of Force subject matter expert in Nova Scotia has been engaged. We anticipate receiving a completed report in approximately 7 days.
- A company in Alberta has been engaged to produce a three dimensional computer image and report regarding the scene. We anticipate receiving this report in approximately 45 days.
- Investigators have contacted the Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions and have arranged for a meeting to discuss the investigation.



Future Steps:

- Upon receipt of the two outstanding reports, investigators will require 14 days to complete their final investigation report.
- Justice Riche has advised that upon receipt of the RCMP's final investigation report, he requires 14 days to complete his independent observer report.

The above noted timelines are only estimates as unforeseen circumstances could arise at any time during the course of this or any investigation.
