Sgt OSMOND sent an e-mail to David COCHRANE at his On Point e-mail address, asking if he could assist in making contact with witness(s) that he quoted as having heard gunfire around the time of the event.

1129 hrs - David COCHRANE called Sgt OSMOND back and advised that he has no direct knowledge of who the neighbor may have been. Mark CRITCH was the reporter who was sent to the scene at the time the story broke and he relayed the information from field interviews he had completed. COCHRANE took the information from reports files by CRITCH.

CRITCH works the night shift, so COCHRANE will have Peter GULLAGE (News Director) speak with CRITCH and GULLAGE will respond to OSMOND.

2015-04-21

OSMOND never heard from Mr. GULLAGE. Inquiries to be made.

2015-04-22 1605 hrs

Sgt OSMOND sent another e-mail to David COCHRANE asking for an update.

2015-04-23 1430 hrs

Sgt OSMOND was called by Peter GULLAGE of CBC. he advised that he had spoken with Mark QUINN their field reporter about this issue. QUINN did not know the name of the person he was speaking to...he was speaking to people gathered outside the police tape line just after the shooting.

All QUINN remembers is that the person was allowed to go behind the police tape to go back to their own residence, so it must have been a next door neighbor.

Realizing this has already been completed, still suggest speaking with Richard DUNPHY about this, or neighbor on the other side of Donald DUNPHY's home. Should tell them what QUINN said and ask them if they have further information they would like to share.
