Good afternoon Paul,

Further to our discussion. "B" Division MCU East is currently investigating a shooting incident within the RCMP jurisdiction by an on-duty Royal Newfoundland Constabulary (RNC) Officer resulting in a civilian death on April 5th, 2015. In the interest of transparency and public confidence Justice David Riche (retired) has been engaged by the RCMP as an independent observer.

The OIC "B" Division Major Crime, Insp. Pat Cahill, has inquired through the OIC "B" Division Criminal Operations as to if "H" Division Criminal Operations, with your OIC's approval, would be able to reach out to the Nova Scotia Serious Incident Response Team (SiRT) in Halifax to determine if they have a specific checklist or guide used when investigating Officer Involved Shootings:
