Steph:

As the file now stands the investigation (ground work / statements etc) from our perspective are complete. We are however waiting on several reports from external sources that are currently in process. Once these reports make their way back they will quickly be added to the master report.

The outstanding reports include

- 1) a report from the subject matter expert for Use of Force (H Division RCMP) (currently completed and should be forwarded to the investigator shortly)
- 2) a report from Bulletproof Forensic Consulting which are currently reviewing the ballistic evidence, comparing the evidence to the re enactment, statements and completing a written report as well as a 3D Computer Model of the scene. (30 days for completion and another two weeks after for the 3D Computer Model Image middle to end of December 2015)
- 3) Justice Riche Independent Observer Report which will comment on the transparency and thoroughness of the investigation. (Once he recieves the remaining outstanding reports he will have his report completed in 2 weeks.)
- 4) If we send to an external police force for review additional time will be required. (2 months)

It should be noted that the above noted external reports could not be started until the file exhibits were processed. The exhibits reports were not received from the Lab until September 2015.

Once the above noted reports are completed the investigator will only require a couple of weeks to do the final assembly .

We are anticipating the completion of the final report towards the end of December or first part of January barring any unforeseen delays. If an external police review is requested it will add several months onto this timeline.
