

SMYTH opens intelligence file to assess the level of threat.</p> <p>2015/04/03 w</p>	 <p>SMYTH Identifies DUNPHY SMYTH continues research and identifies subject Donald DUNPHY. He continues research into DUNPHY'S Twitter account history and locates DUNPHY'S address through a workers compensation file.</p> <p>2015/04/04 w</p>	 <p>SMYTH Conducts Indices Checks SMYTH determines the need to assess DUNPHY in person. Further research was conducted using available police databases to ensure officer safety. No indicators of public violence or firearm infractions were noted.</p> <p>2015/04/05 w</p>	 <p>SMYTH arrives at DUNPHY residence SMYTH arrives at the residence of Donald DUNPHY. He knocks on a window but it seems that DUNPHY is not at home. SMYTH notes anti-political signage on the residence.</p> <p>2015/04/05 1:22:00 PM</p>	 <p>SMYTH attends Neighbour/Brother's residence SMYTH attends residence of Richard DUNPHY, brother of Donald. SMYTH is told that Donald is "difficult to deal with". Richard does not believe that there are any firearms in Donald's house.</p> <p>2015/04/05 w</p>	 <p>SMYTH Returns to DUNPHY Residence As SMYTH leaves the residence of Richard DUNPHY, he decides to make another attempt to contact Donald. Donald DUNPHY is home and invites SMYTH into his living room. DUNPHY takes a seat in a chair. SMYTH remains standing.</p> <p>2015/04/05 approx 1400h</p>	 <p>DUNPHY becomes Suspicious Although initially cordial, DUNPHY becomes suspicious over SMYTH to his home. SMYTH assures DUNPHY that he is not being arrested and that he just wanted to speak about the co that were sent from his Twitter ac. DUNPHY grows more agitated but seated. ● Attempts to Diffuse the Situation
 SMYTHE purposely makes presence of reviewing folder in his hands so show DUNPHY that he isn't scanning the room. SMYTHE hoped that this could abate DUNPHY'S suspicion and help calm him.

● SMYTHE Recognizes Firearm
 SMYTHE notices the barrel of a firearm appear in his peripheral vision from the right side of DUNPHY'S chair. He recognizes a small barrel and box.

2015/04/05 2:00:17 PM

● SMYTHE Draws His Weapon/Shots Fired
 Upon seeing the firearm SMYTHE drops the folder, raises his hand and draws his pistol. SMYTHE moves toward the door and the mouth of the rifle followed his path. SMYTHE yells "no no no no no" and fires his pistol twice toward the center mass of DUNPHY. DUNPHY remains in control of the rifle and keeps tracking SMYTHE'S movement to the door. SMYTHE fires one shot toward the head of DUNPHY and then a second as he moved through the entry way which did make impact with the side of DUNPHY'S head.

● SMYTHE Re-enters the Livingroom
 SMYTHE cautiously enters the livingroom and prepares to engage the threat for the second time. The rifle is now on the floor. It appears that DUNPHY is deceased. SMYTHE checks DUNPHY'S breathing and noted none. SMYTHE retreats to the cover of the entry way to prepare for possible subsequent threat from neighbouring family or any other person that might be in the residence.

● RCMP OCC Alerted
 SMYTHE calls RCMP OCC to advise shots fired and request paramedics and RCMP members attend.

2015/04/05 2:28:00 PM

● RNC OCC Alerted
 SMYTHE calls RNC OCC and asks the operator to notify the Duty NCO.

approximately 1433h

● SMYTHE Exits Residence
 SMYTHE remains in residence for about 15 minutes. Does a haphazard clearing of residence. Does another cursory check on DUNPHY. Regains composure and reassesses the immediate threat situation. Reholsters his weapon. He goes outside and retrieves some water to drink from his vehicle.


● SMYTHE Turns on Emergency Lights
