Report:

1410 hrs. I attended the office of Donna IVEY (Special Assistant Communications Director) who provided an audio recorded statement. She provided the following information in her statement:

- As part of her duties she monitors media including social media and also posts to the Government FB Page and the Premiers' page.
- On Good Friday, she was at home browsing through media and noted a series of tweets composed by "Donahue2DonDunphy"
- The tweets were in response to a tweet by Minister COLLINS but did not appear related to his initial tweet.
- There were 6 or 7 tweets the majority of which were not threatening in any way and simply dissatisfaction with Workers Comp. She was aware of Mr DUNPHY's posts as he had posted in the past expressing the same types of concerns.
- One of the 7 tweets did concern her as there was some mention of 'hurting' family members. She felt the "Hurt" may have be a physical threat and forwarded the message via email to Sgt. SMYTH and Cpl NOEL for their action.
- This was not a unique occurrence and it is not uncommon for staff to forward letters, tweets etc to Protective Services for assessment.
- Later that afternoon, or on Saturday, SMYTH called her for some context regarding Don DUNPHY. She explained that she didn't have a lot of information other than he was an injured worker who was disgruntled. She suggested that Joe call Workers Comp who might be able to provide more information.
- On Sunday, she was cooking Easter dinner and heard on the media that there had been a shooting in Mitchells Brook. She later received a call from Communications Director Heather McCLEAN who asked her to forward her initial email to McCLEAN.
- She then did some research and noted a Don DUNPHY in Mitchells Brook and was fairly certain it was related to the tip she had passed on to Sgt SMYTH.
- This concluded her involvement in the matter

1420 hrs. Conclusion of the interview. Ms IVEY advised that she would forward me the email communications she had in relation to her involvement. When I arrived back at HQ, the emails were in my account. I printed same and added them to the associated folder.

This task recommended for conclusion here. The noted emails, my handwritten notes, this report and a CD containing the audio recorded statement forwarded to Cpl BURKE for his review.
