In reviewing the scene photos, I noted that the folder which Sgt SMYTH was holding at the time appeared to have come to rest precariously on the edge of the table in Mr DUNPHY residence. None of the documents appeared to have come out of the folder. On this date, Cpl FOOTE and I attended to the lounge area of the HQ barracks in an effort to film a demonstration to determine whether this final resting place is objectively reasonable. Cpl FOOTE video recorded me dropping the folder approximately 8 times on a coffee table which was roughly the same height as the table in the DUNPHY residence. The folder dropped to the floor on two or three occasions, it dropped directly on the table and also dropped partially on the table on other attempts. The contents of the folder remained in tact during all attempts. Video forwarded to Cpl FOOTE for addition to the file.
