The .ppsx file is a PowerPoint Show designed as a visual supplement to the above noted report. The .pdf file contains images of the PowerPoint Show slides for printing. There is one video included in the PowerPoint Show that is a fly around view of the scene. While it should play in most circumstances, the playback of embedded videos in PowerPoint can be unpredictable depending on the computer being used. The .avi file included is a higher quality version of the video in the PowerPoint Show and is playable on most common media players. The fly around view plays fairly quickly by default; however, it was primarily designed to show different points of view as still images by clicking on different locations on the progress (scrub) bar while paused.

The files on the USB Flash Drive are encrypted and require a password to open. The password will be provided to you via email. Once the USB is installed, open the application "SanDiscSecureAccessV3_win" and you will be prompted for the password. A folder called "DUNPHY presentation" will then be visible which contains the above-mentioned files.
